BRIDGE-IPRO LIMITED is an Appointed Representative of BRIDGE INSURANCE BROKERS LIMITED (of the same address) who are authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority for insurance mediation/distribution and credit broking purposes.

LAWFUL BASIS OF PROCESSING

We set out here our lawful basis of processing.

If you fill in a Request for Quote (RFQ) on our site certain personal information will be provided by you. The purpose of our site is provision of insurance terms from an insurer.

Where applicable your data will also be provided to a premium finance provider so as to enable premium payment in connection with insurance we arrange for you.

Our lawful basis of processing data is that of effecting a contract.

Personal data is also used for our legal obligation in complying with the following Terrorist Asset-Freezing etc. Act 2010 Counter Terrorism Act 2008 Anti-Terrorism, Crime and Security Act 2001 and any amending or subsequent legislation.

In addition we enable you to return to the site at any time to retrieve quotations and in the case of insurance policies arranged to download your policies and associated documentation. In order to provide this service, and keep it secure, we ask you to register with us. We store your personal information, along with information about any quotations provided to you on a secure platform.

We also analyse activity of visitors to this site and as part of this we use cookies and other tracking technologies. Refer to our **COOKIES** section below.

We ask you for information to assess your insurance needs. This information is then used to provide a quotation, Without this information it is difficult or impossible to provide an accurate quotation. Our lawful basis of use of personal data is contractual performance and should any personal data be provided in respect of health or regarding convictions and/or offences the lawful basis is that of substantial public interest.

USE OF PERSONAL DATA

In addition to the use of data described above we will use information to

- Establish and maintain communications with you
- Process transactions
- Facilitate premium payment
- Handle any claims that may arise
- Where necessary to comply with legal, security, processing and regulatory requirements
- Protecting against fraud, suspicious and illegal activities
 To help prevent financial crime, your details may be submitted by insurers to fraud prevention agencies and other organisations where your records may be searched, including the Claims and Underwriting Exchange (CUE) and the Motor Insurers Anti-Fraud and Theft Register (MIAFTR).
- Keep you updated as regards insurances arranged and inform you about products and services we believe will be of interest to you

WHO DO WE SHARE DATA WITH?

Data is shared in connection with arranging insurance, facilitating premium payment and handling any claims that may arise.

Third parties to whom we disclose any personal data are required by law and contractual undertakings to keep personal data confidential and secure and use and disclose such data only for purposes that a reasonable person would consider appropriate in the circumstances and in compliance with applicable legislation.

We do not sell or trade your information with anyone else and we never will.

CATEGORIES OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

What are cookies?
